
PSALM 63

Served as a form of temple worship for the templeless people God









"A PSALM OF DAVID. WHEN HE WAS IN THE DESERT OF JUDAH."



JUDEAN WILDERNESS

The scene of authorship of Psalm 63 for David was the desert / wilderness of Judea

He had fled to escape - either from Saul (1 Samuel 23-24) or from Absalom (2 Samuel 15-16)

This almost definitely the same area where Jesus fasted and was tempted/tested in the wilderness

1 You, God, are my God, earnestly I seek you; I thirst for you, my whole being longs for you, in a dry and parched land where there is no water.

SEEK, AND FIND, THE LORD IN THE PLACE WHERE YOU FIND YOURSELF

GOD, YOU ARE MY GOD

'ě·lō·hîm 'āt·tāh 'ê·lî (creator / maker / god(s), You are the god of me)

Who, or what, is the god of You?

David was literally parched... may your need (thirst) drive you toward The Lord, not further from Him

WHAT DO YOU LONG FOR?

SO MY SOUL LONGS FOR YOU, LORD

- As a lifelong fan longs for their team to win a cup...
- As a teen longs for the new game console release...
- As a thirsty deer pants for fresh water...
- As a wounded soldier longs for healing...
- As a victim of trafficking longs for freedom...
- A the Christ longed for His cup to be taken...

EVEN IF THE CIRCUMSTANCE WE ARE IN DOESN'T CHANGE, YET STILL WE CAN SEEK, KNOW HIM AND CHOOSE TO PURSUE HIS WILL

THE FOUNTAIN OF LIFE

We can consider the 'dry and parched' land allegorically - in a spiritual sense

But Christ promises us water that does not run dry and that can overflow from within us

We can seek and know His presence at any time and in any place...

2 I have seen you in the sanctuary and beheld your power and your glory.

When things feel dry, remember who God is and times of refreshing in Him

PRESENCE PEOPLE

David was remembering and longing for the temple sanctuary where he had tasted God's presence

Jesus told us that worship and our experience of God's presence is no longer about geography

The temple of the Lord is not found in a building but in the body of Christ; the Living Stones

3 Because your love is better than life, my lips will glorify you.

WHAT IS THE MOST WONDERFUL THING ON EARTH?

NOTHING IS BETTER THAN THE LOVE OF GOD

PROCLAMATION PEOPLE

Our worship to Him is a response to revelation

The psalmist knew the truth that the love of God is better than anything this life can offer

When you find something wonderful - your lips have to declare it!

4 I will praise you as long as I live, and in your name I will lift up my hands.

PRAISE PEOPLE

King David's life was not a perfect picture of pure worship but he had a heart after God and was determined to respond to the goodness of God with praise throughout his days

The lifting of hands - praise, surrender, looking up Our praise should be physical as well as verbal

5 I will be fully satisfied as with the richest of foods; with singing lips my mouth will praise you.



WE CAN GET FULL SATISFACTION... FROM THE HUNGER AND HEAT OF THE WILDERNESS DAVID COULD SEE FULL SATISFACTION THROUGH THE EYES OF FAITH

6 On my bed I remember you; I think of you through the watches of the night.

WE DECIDE WHAT WE MEDIATE ON THROUGH THE 'WATCHES OF THE NIGHT'

PREMEDITATED PEOPLE!

Our beds often become the place of worry but we need to take those thoughts captive

The psalms keep bringing us back to this theme of meditation; running things around in our minds

Strategise in advance how to take hold of unhelpful thoughts and fill your mind with God's Word

7 Because you are my help, I sing in the shadow of your wings.



IN THE HEAT OF THE DESERT, WE FIND REST UNDER THE SHADOW OF HIS WINGS

8 I cling to you; your right hand upholds me.

This is a two way relationship - we cling to Him, only to find He was holding us all along!

9 Those who want to kill me will be destroyed; they will go down to the depths of the earth.

10 They will be given over to the sword and become food for jackals.

WE CAN TRUST IN THE JUSTICE OF THE LORD

TRUST IN THE LORD

David had fled for his life - either from King Saul who was threatened by him, or from his own son Absalom, who sought to usurp him

Rightly or wrongly he believed he would be vindicated and his oppressors punished

When we are mistreated, we can still trust God

JESUS RAISED THE BAR EVEN HIGHER

GUARD YOUR OWN HEART

Jesus was by no means gentle in His words toward the unjust, the proud, the oppressors

Yet, as He was crucified he said 'Father, forgive them for they know not what they do' (Luke 23:34)

You must look after your own heart and trust God to be the righteous judge of others

11 But the king will rejoice in God; all who swear by God will glory in him, while the mouths of liars will be silenced.

See the difference between the mouth that praises God, and the mouth that forges lies. The first shall never be stopped, but shall sing on forever. The second shall be made speechless at the bar of God. O Lord, we seek you and your truth; deliver us from all malice and slander, and reveal to us your own self, for Jesus' sake. Amen.
